

I WON! Now What Do I Do?

Following a competition, we display:

- (1) Winning first place images on our web site (www.baltimorecameraclub.com) and
- (2) Complete results with all image placements on Visual Pursuits (www.baltimorecameraclub.com/Competitions/CompetitionResults)

If your image placed in a PRINT competition:

- (1) Upload a copy of your image into the VP competition that had been created to collect and display the placements.
 - a. There are two VP competitions - one for monochrome and one for color.
 - b. The VP competitions will be dated 6 days after the original print competition (For example a Thursday, January 31 Print Competition has VP date of Wednesday, February 6).
- (2) Complete your upload by 11:00 pm on the specified Wednesday, six days after the competition.
- (3) Images should be jpeg files sized to 800 pixels on the longest side.
- (4) Sharpen your images for digital display if desired but please do not make any other substantive changes. Images should be a close representation of the printed image you placed.
- (5) Title your images with the title used in the competition.
- (6) The VP database will automatically tag the image with your name and competition level. The image must be uploaded by you in order to be tagged with your name.
- (7) If you do not have a VP account, you must create one <http://www.baltimorecameraclub.com/>. After you have created the account.

The competition administrators will create the results display (<https://www.baltimorecameraclub.com/Competitions/CompetitionResults.aspx>) and link it to the club website (baltimorecameraclub.org) once all images are uploaded.

IWe recommend that you leave your print in the care of the club for the Year-end competition

If your image placed in a DIGITAL competition:

You do not need to do anything!

The results will display immediately in Visual Pursuits (<https://www.baltimorecameraclub.com/Competitions/CompetitionResults.aspx>). The competition administrators update the club website (baltimorecameraclub.org) as soon as possible.

What do we do with winning images?

All images that place 1st through 5th and Honorable Mention are eligible for the Year--end competition. Winning prints are kept safely in storage at the church and winning digital images are archived until the Year-end competition. If you prefer to take your winning print(s) home, they should be returned at the last monthly competition for the Year-end competition.
